## Progressive Easing of COVID-19 Restrictions

With the recent announcement from the Provincial Government on the final restrictions on COVID-19 safety measures to be lifted by the end of April (e.g. no mandatory masking is required), the Re-Opening Committee has therefore reviewed the best possible progressive approach to further easing of MCAC safety measures as follows:

**Eventbrite, Door Screening** - will not be required as of March 20, 2022. Announcement will be made on March 13, 2022. Courtesy temperature check and hand sanitizing stations will be available.

**Social Distancing** will be maintained at least till mid-late April. Re-assessment of such measures will be conducted in mid-late April with guidelines to be provided.

**Masking** - will re-assess the masking requirements 4 weeks after Province-wide masking turned optional (i.e. April 21). Guidelines will be provided in due course, most likely in late April or earlier.

**Food consumption** - will reassess food consumption and preparation in late April and will provide guidelines in early May.



## Progressive Easing of COVID-19 Restrictions

**Sunday School In-Person Classes** - wait until easing of the social distancing restrictions. Most likely available for the semester starting in June.

Outreach Programs – will be reviewed by the Outreach Pastor in conjunction with the Senior Pastor. Should there be any need to review with the Elder Board, this will be at the discretion of the Senior Pastor. Timing will be subject to easing of certain safety restrictions.

Response to sudden surge of COVID-19 cases and immediate re-application of all necessary safety measures – in the unfortunate event of immediate reapplication of all necessary safety measures, it will be at the discretion of the Senior Pastor to act in a timely fashion with a briefing note to the Elder Board to outline all actions being taken.
