A PARENTAL PLEDGE

A BIBLICAL PRACTICE

A precedent for the ceremony of baby dedication is found throughout the Scriptures. Hannah and Elkanah presented their son, Samuel, to the Lord, *"For this boy I prayed, and the Lord has given me my petition which I asked of Him. So I have also dedicated him to the Lord; as long as he lives, he is dedicated to the Lord; and he (Elkanah) worshipped the Lord there."* (I Samuel 1:27-28)

Paul reminded Timothy of his spiritual heritage: "For I am mindful of the sincere faith within you, which first dwelt in your grandmother, Lois, and your mother, Eunice, and I am sure that it is in you as well... from childhood you have known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus." (II Timothy 1:5, 3:15)

Mary and Joseph presented Jesus back to God in an act of worship and dedication, "When the days of their purification according to the law of Moses were completed, they (Joseph and Mary) brought Him to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord"..."And the Child continued to grow and become strong, increasing in wisdom; and the grace of God was upon Him."

(Luke 2:22, 40)

As a grown man, our Lord loved the little children: "And they began bringing children to Him, so that He might touch them; and the disciples rebuked them. But when Jesus saw this, he was indignant and said to them 'Permit the children to come to me; do not hinder them; for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. Truly I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it at all.' And He took them in His arms and began blessing them, laying His hands upon them". (Mark 10:13-16)
